Purpose & activities:

Interfaith Action is a not for profit organisation working with young people and students (aged 14-25) from all faith backgrounds, across London to develop youth-led interfaith volunteer projects. We increase understanding and respect between people of all faiths (and none), whilst participating in volunteer projects with environmental, community and social benefit.

We are currently developing our website and updating our online resources, including information on each of the major faith traditions in the UK (see current information on www.interact-uk.org.uk, see Resources, and Faiths) . We would also like to develop further resources on government and public sector policy with relation to faith and inter-faith.

We are looking for volunteers to help us research and write these new resources. We require 6 - 8 volunteers for resources on each of the major faith traditions (Baha'i, Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, Jewish, Muslim, Sikh). We are also interested to hear from people able to write resources on Jainism, Zoroastrianism, Shinto and other faith traditions), we are also interested to hear from people who have a specific interest or knowledge of a single Christian denominations (e.g. Catholic, Anglican, Methodist) and or the differences between the main Christian denominations.

We are also looking for 2 volunteers to develop our Government & Policy section of the website, if you have a specific interest or knowledge in this area, we would like to hear from you.

Skills / Experience required:

- Strong written communication skills
- *To write religion/faith resources* - Good general knowledge of your faith tradition / religion; and or ability to research a particular tradition of interest
- *To write Government & Public Sector Policy resources* – ability to research and / or knowledge of interfaith & voluntary sectors relationship with government and public policy
- Previous experience of developing resources desirable
